EXAMINING SPINAL DISC INJURIES



Spinal discs are soft tissue structures that separate the vertebrae in your spine. They aid in its flexibility and shock absorption. Injuries to these discs can be quite problematic, but are treatable. Injuries fall into two categories. The more widely known of these are disc herniations. These can be bulges, protrusions, extrusions, or sequestrations. With the first three the inner disc material is bulging into or through the disc's outer layers, but it is still intact. With a sequestered herniation there is a free fragment of the disc that has separated from the disc and is floating in the space nearby. All can be problematic because they cause back/neck pain and weakness and can lead to irritation of adjacent sensitive nerves. This irritation occurs either by direct compression of the nerve or by an increase in inflammation in the area. In addition to back/neck pain the patient may then experience buttock, thigh, leg, foot, shoulder, arm, or hand symptomatology. This symptomatology may include such sensations as pain, numbness, pins and needles, weakness, or clumsiness of the lower/upper extremities. The other category of disc injury is called internal disc derangement syndrome, or IDDS. With IDDS some type of injury or repetitive stress and strain creates a small tear or tears in the disc and leads to a loss of its fluid. In this case there may not be the typical lower/upper extremity nerve symptomatology. Instead, isolated back/neck pain and weakness will be the complaint. This disc injury may progress to

one of the types of herniation discussed earlier. Conservative treatment includes techniques to correct the structure and mechanics of the disc and spine. In addition, therapy is utilized to stabilize and support the spine at the area of involvement. In some cases, surgical treatment may be necessary.

flowers and the flavors they provide. Squash Blossoms have a mild vegetable flavor and blossoms from all types of squash are edible. And just think about this: the more blossoms you eat, the fewer zucchini you'll have to cook or give to the neighbors!

Calendulas have been called "poor man's saffron". To use as saffron, pick the daisy-like petals, chop them, then cook with oil to bring out the color and flavor.

Marigolds Tagetes tenuifolia "Lemon Gem" and "Tangerine Gem" have a citrus-tarragon flavor; other marigolds aren't really edible. To use them, pull off the bitter, white right-angled portion of the petals before using.


